WHEREAS, Purdue Student housing concerns are a serious issue that affects Purdue college students as a whole;

WHEREAS, According to the Purdue University website, “New freshmen who are admitted for fall are guaranteed on-campus housing in University Residences if they submit a contract,” and according to student records and first-hand accounts this has not been the case;

WHEREAS, Newly admitted freshmen have been placed in temporary housing and have then been relocated to dorms and apartments with serious cases of black mold;

WHEREAS, RAs are forced to live with roommates, due to the overabundance of students with nowhere else to live. Thus hindering their ability to do their job as confidantes for the new attendees and as hosts of comfortable environments to hang out and study;

Therefore, be it ENACTED,

that Purdue Student Senate establish the Purdue Student Government Committee on The Housing Crises at Purdue as an Ad-Hoc committee chaired by Senator Renae Kramer for the current Senate session composed of Purdue Student Government officers and members as well as other individuals beholden to the interests of the committee.
