WHEREAS, Article VI of the constitution of Purdue Student Government gives a category of subordinate bodies that members of the organization are in to reside over and run; and

WHEREAS, All of these subordinate bodies, but one, are no longer active or are not necessary to the function of the organization in general and therefore should not be under governing rule; and

WHEREAS, The striking of this Article in the constitution will have long term effects that will ultimately help multiple parties be able to have much more time and control over their initiatives and eliminate redundancy with other standing committees within the organization and within the governing documents;

WHEREAS, Section III under this article can be moved under the description of the treasurer, as that position will still oversee the Student Fee Advisory Board, making it simpler to find duties of the treasurer while keeping the only active subordinate body.

Therefore, be it ENACTED,

that Article VI of the Constitution of Purdue Student Government be taken out of the constitution all together; and

that Article IV, Section 1, Part B ,#5(d) ii. be stated as “Serve as a non-voting member on the subordinate body that is called the Student Fee Advisory Board which shall be a permanent, stand-alone committee that reports to the Purdue Student Government Senate. The mission and purpose of the SFAB shall be defined in a subordinate document to this Constitution, called the Constitution of the Student Fee Advisory Board, which shall define the rights and functions of SFAB.”.
