WHEREAS, The Executive Director of Governmental Relations for Purdue Student Government is charged with acting as a liaison between the student body and state and local government for the betterment of our students; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section II, Part A., Subsection 2-d requires that “the Purdue Student Government Student Senate approves of the effort through the passing of a resolution”

Therefore, be it RESOLVED,

that the Board of Governmental Relations shall advocate in its communication with state government: to introduce legislation that would protect individuals from hate and bias in Indiana, punitive laws to address sexual assault and harassment, improvement of state government’s approach to mental health issues, and expansion of the Indiana Lifeline Law; and

that the Board of Governmental Relations shall advocate in its communication with local government and university administration for: expansion and improvement of mental health and counseling services, improved access for individuals with disabilities (or otherwise needing accommodation) on campus, and improved responses to sexual harassment and assault cases.
