*WHEREAS,* Purdue and Purdue Student Government are committed to respecting and valuing diversity; and

*WHEREAS,* Purdue Student Government is the voice of the Purdue student body and has an obligation to protect the culture, rights, and identities of students; and

*WHEREAS,* Students of Purdue University have come forward to the Board of Governmental Relations with statements where they have been personally insulted and ridiculed based on their heritage, specifically referring to anti-semitism; and

*WHEREAS,* Purdue Student Government is already an established partner with Indiana Forward through the Board of Governmental Relations, which has made continuously addressing hate crimes a long-term priority goal and core responsibility;

**Therefore, be it ENACTED,**

that Purdue Student Government stands firmly against anti-Semitism and any other remarks made against identities of all Purdue students both online and publicly on Purdue University’s campus, and will work continuously to address this problem at both the campus and state levels; and

that the passage of this resolution would aid Purdue’s commitment to stand against hate crimes on a state level if it were delivered to the Purdue Graduate Student Government to be discussed and voted upon accordingly.
